CATHEDRAL OF STRASBOURG

With its 142-meter-high spire, the cathedral and its pink sandstone facade dominate the entire Alsace plain. Be entranced by this gothic masterpiece, the quintessential symbol of Strasbourg.

LA PETITE FRANCE

Discover the most picturesque district of old Strasbourg, La Petite France, which is classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This district, built on the water, was home to fishermen, millers, and tanners. The magnificent half-timbered houses, dating back to the 16th and 17th centuries, feature sloping roofs with attics where hides were once dried. Unfortunately, the district was completely destroyed during World War II, but Strasbourg undertook a post-war reconstruction policy to restore its picturesque charm.

QUAI DES BATELIERS

The Quai des Bateliers (Boatmen's Quay) gets its name from the boatmen who used to reside there. This quay boasts beautiful houses from the 16th to 18th century, featuring half-timbering, corbelling, or oriel windows, some of which are designated as historical monuments.

BATORAMA

Batorama provides unique tours of Strasbourg. Take a boat ride on the river to discover the city's historical treasures and cultural heritage. This is an unforgettable experience that will give you a unique perspective of Strasbourg.
