In the spirit of the area, most of the above would be better described as polysexual or even post-gay; of the bunch, the Joiner's positions itself as a friendly, local gay bar, though things can get a bit 'out of hand' on weekend nights (expect to queue if it's late and to get very sweaty once inside). Loungelover is a classy cocktail bar, brought to you by the legendary Trois Garçons, whose eponymous restaurant (at 1 Club Row, E1) backs on to the bar and is stuffed with taxidermy, crystals and curiosities. The three 'boys' live upstairs and also own a furniture shop, Maison Trois Garçons, on nearby Redchurch Street (no. 45).

**Bijou**: "the cocktail social for women", every Saturday night at Cos Bar, 148 Queen Victoria St, EC4V 4BY

**GutterIsut**: 'full-on' monthly party from the Dalston Gay Mafia – the next is on 25<sup>th</sup> August at East Bloc, 217 City Rd, London EC1V 1JN

**Prick Up Your Ears**: every Thursday at East Bloc, 217 City Rd, London EC1V 1JN **Way Out Club**: the name says it all at London's weekly transgender knees-up, attracting a wildly mixed bunch and offering changing facilities and make-up lessons. Every Saturday at Abbey Bar, 30-33 Minories, EC3N 1DD

**XXL**: claims to be the biggest bear club in the world; certainly it's laid out across a huge dancefloor, two bars and a beer garden, but the crowd's surprisingly mixed (not just bears but bear and bear-cub lovers) and the atmosphere's very friendly.

There's something for almost everyone, though it must be said that the scene here tends towards the edgier end of the spectrum (XXL apart). If you're looking for something or somewhere more mainstream, head to Heaven underneath the arches at Charing Cross or to the late-night bars in Soho, traditionally London's 'gay village' with Old Compton Street at its epicentre. Muscle Marys flock to Vauxhall.
