**Boston LGBT Pride Week:**

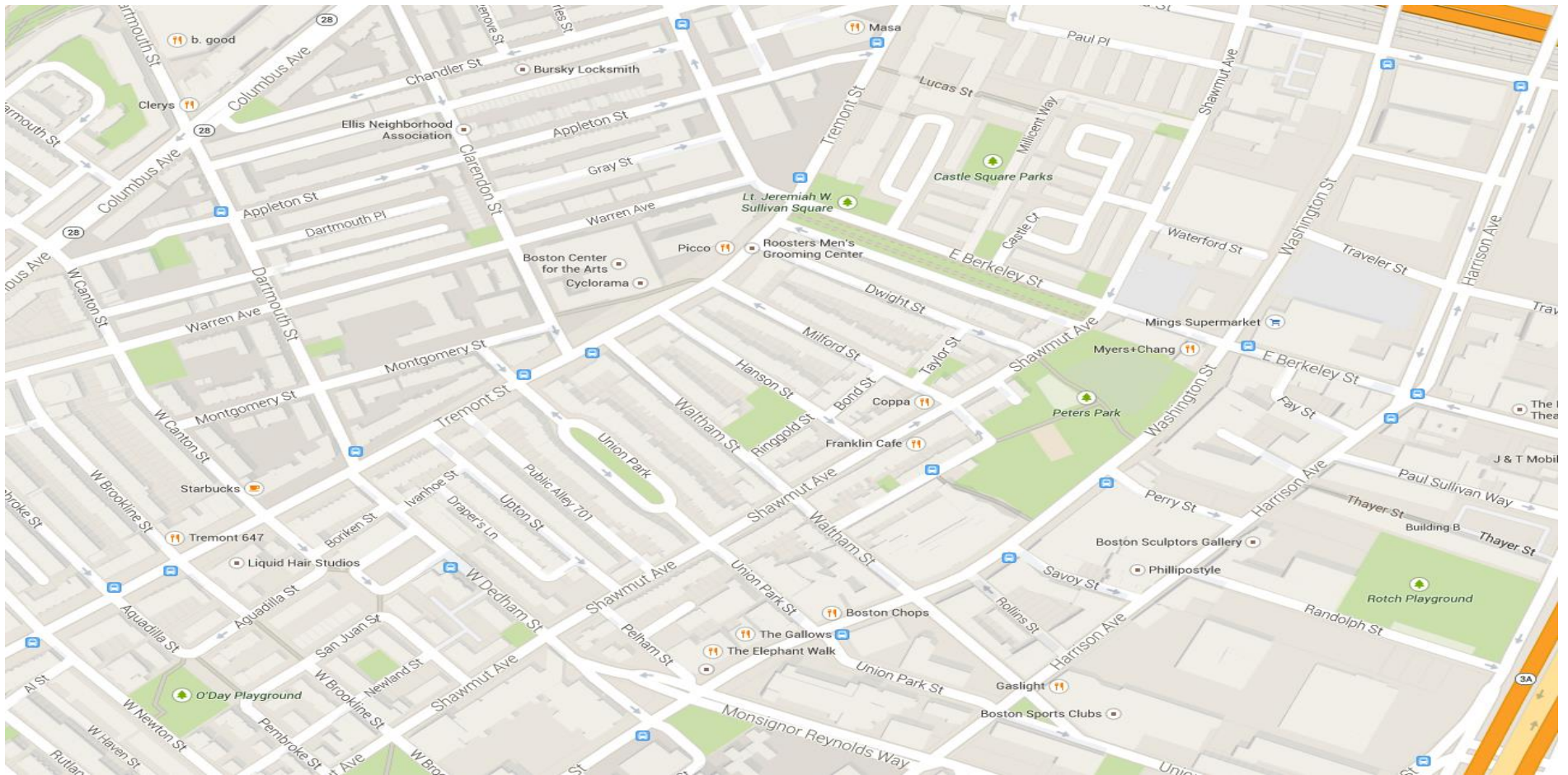
