


The Out and About Travel Guide Kyiv

We recommend the next sightseeing Highlights In Kyiv:

You may walk down the **Andriivskyy Descent** (Ukrainian: *Andriyivs'kyi uzviz*) is one of the oldest and most popular streets connecting Kiev's Upper Town neighborhood and the historically commercial Podil neighborhood.

The descent, 720 metres (2,360 ft) in length, is constructed of laid cobblestones The Andriivskyy Descent is marked by a couple historic landmarks, including the Castle of Richard the Lionheart, the 18th century baroque Saint Andrew's Church, famed Russian writer Mikhail Bulgakov's house, the Museum of One Street, chronicling the Andriivskyy Descent's history, and numerous other monuments.



The Railway Museum located in the main railway station (Kyiv-Passazhirskiy).

This cute and small museum presents an exhibition of historic locomotives and wagons.

Access from the main bridge, or from the underpass, the last 14th platform. The museum is easy to find, you can see it from the transition between the main and the south stations.

The museum exhibits the different stages in the development of rail transport in Ukraine: pre-revolutionary, Soviet, and modern. The exhibition features locomotives, passenger and freight cars, and some other railway exhibits.



You may discover the passenger couches and have a possibility to visit them inside. You can climb to the driver's cabin

We advise you to visit a **Museum of Folk Architecture and Folkways of Ukraine Pyrohiv**. It is must see attraction in Kiev!

The territory of historic Pyrohiv now serves as the location of a 1.5-square-kilometre (370-acre) outdoor Museum of Folk Architecture and Life of Ukraine. The museum contains over 300 pieces of folk architecture brought here from all parts of Ukraine and carefully reassembled. The entire territory of the museum is divided into sectors, each representing the folk architecture and life of a specific Ukrainian region.



The oldest church, situated in Pyrohiv, is Naddnipyrianska, it is built in 1742. In the museum you can also find more than 40 000 items of household and traditional culture such as costumes, old textiles, embroidery, carpets, ceramics, metal handicrafts, woodwork and glass-ware as well as musical instruments, paintings and houseware.

To get to the museum from the underground station Demiivska take the trolley bus №11 or from the underground station Demiivska or Golosiivska the minibus taxi №172 and 156. The museum's working hours are from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. There are excursions for tourists in English, Ukrainian, Russian and German.

Gay club LIFT
