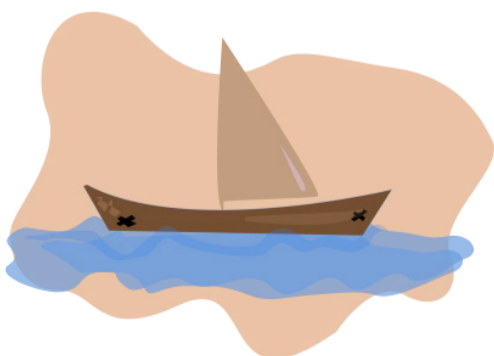
## THINGS TO DO IN EAST LONDON
