

## LGBTQ ACTIVITY RECOMMENDATION

### PARK

#### **LUMPINI PARK**

The green zone in the city. This is where businessmen, tourists and Bangkok residents come to jog. Older folks practice their Tai Chi while others just Relax in the fresh environment. Lumpini Park is the first public park in Bangkok. It is a multi-functional park where people can do several outdoor leisure activities under fresh air and shade. A lot of flora and fauna and a large lake can be seen in the park.

### SHOPPING

#### **ICONSIAM**

Luxury international brands located on the riverside and easy to access by the sky train.

#### **SIAM PARAGON**

The popular mall boasts a wide selection of international luxury brands and spotlights in trend, unique and chic fashion designed by local designers. Just a quick Sky Train ride, only 3 stops from The Standard, Bangkok Mahanakhon.

### ROOFTOP BAR

#### **SKY BEACH – THE STANDARD, BANGKOK MAHANAKHON**

Get sky-high with us at Sky Beach, the highest rooftop bar in Bangkok. Grab a seat, have a bite, watch the sunset, sip on cocktail (or two), and remember that the sky's the limit at Sky Beach.

### GAY BARS

#### **SILOM SOI 4**

The place to see and be seen. Confidently strut your stuff along the alley, pick a bar and get a table with the best viewing position. Best time to go is after 9pm. Near to Sala Daeng BTS station or MRT Silom

#### **THE BALCONY**

Enjoy a drink, have dinner, meet some old friends, make some new ones - upstairs or downstairs. It's always fun at The Balcony. The two terraces are the most popular spots in the soi to grab a drink and to see and be seen in Bangkok's gayest soi. It is also the place to experience the excitement of Soi 4 from a new height and try your hand at karaoke.

#### **THE STRANGER BAR**

The Stranger Bar & Lounge was born from an Irish Drinker Mr. Sean Lestrage in Partnership with Miss M Stranger Fox, The Eleganza Beauty, Funny Extravaganza & Super Friendly Bangkok Drag Queen. Located on Silom 4, the main gay area in Bangkok. Get to know the place from their own nasty Signature Shots "Sperm, Golden Shower and Stranger Slut Hahaha. They're also known for fab DRAG SHOWS, Club Kids Fun events, Private Parties, Birthday Parties. Nightly DJ playing Great pop Top 20, dance, disco, diva music.

#### **G'S BANGKOK**

Bangkok's no.1 homemade-style German & Thai Restaurant, own and run by a German chef who fell in love with Thailand. They serve a curious mix of German and Thai food, that may be accompanied by a selection of German beers and international wines.

#### **SILOM SOI 2**

Silom Soi 2 is home to DJ Station dance club and a few other disco bars. The narrow entrance is easy to miss – there's a Burger King in front of the alley.

## **THE PATIO**

Contemporary-designed, chill-out bar with a more upmarket feel. The music is quiet enough to permit more intimate conversations. Interesting one-way mirror arrangements in the toilets. Located under the same roof as other popular Silom Soi 2 venues.

## **PATPONG AREA**

Patpong 1 and Patpong 2, adjacent to Silom Road. Its night market is a major tourist attraction, with fashion stalls and souvenirs. The stalls compete for attention with the neon signs of the bars, some of which leave their doors open so you can get a preview of what you can find inside.

## **GAY CLUB**

### **DJ STATION**

DJ Station is the main attraction of Silom Soi 2, an enclave of gay bars and clubs next to each other. Not to mention a disco ball, light show and music videos.

### **FAKE CLUB BANGKOK**

Energetic, gay-friendly hot spot featuring table service, laser beams, live music, dancing & DJs. This large club is rather mixed but is mostly for young gay men to get together. Doors open to concerts of Thai and international pop hits, then male models put on a show, and it finally becomes a dance club.

## **GAY MASSAGES**

### **BAANTEWA**

Set in a quiet townhouse, this massage parlor is a short walk from Silom and Chong Nonsi BTS Skytrain Stations. The all-male staff offers Thai massages, body scrubs, aromatherapy and cream massages. Each treatment can last between 60 minutes and two hours.
