



- La Malagueta is a central coastal district facing the beach, famous for its beach bars and busy promenade. Next to the port there are clothing stores of well-known brands, Mediterranean restaurants and ice cream parlors that extend to the emblematic lighthouse of La Farola.
- Malaga city has become one of the most fashionable cities in Europe. There are cultural areas, beaches and the best alternative spaces. The LGBTQ+ community has many bars of interest around.
