DINING

At Hyatt Regency Orlando, you're just minutes from popular culinary hotspots in the International Drive area including Pointe Orlando and Restaurant Row.

NIGHTLIFE

In Orlando's trendy Milk District, which is 10 minutes from downtown, Southern Nights is an LGBTQ+ nightclub that's perfect for dancing the night away. The Milk District is also home to The Plaza Live, which is the only place to see performances by the Orlando Gay Chorus.

At SAVOY Orlando in the Ivanhoe Village Main Street district, the Men of SAVOY dancers perform nightly, making this one of the area's preeminent gay bars. Burlesque can be experienced at Stardust Lounge, right next to beautiful Lake Eola Park.

And in downtown's Church Street District, take in an authentic drag show and other forms of entertainment while enjoying gourmet burgers and a full bar at Hamburger Mary's Bar & Grille. Several other gay and lesbian bars can be found throughout the area.
