1. **Infinity Restaurant** | 9 Lower Long Street, Cape Town, 8000 | +27 21 879 5040
Located at Hotel Sky, offering a glamorous escape with panoramic views. The interior is playfully themed 'afrochic' with animal print dining chairs, chic chandeliers and vibrant splashes of gold.
2. **FYN Restaurant** | 37 Parliament Street, Cape Town, 8001 | +27 21 286 2733
Perched on the fifth floor with stunning views of Table Mountain and Lion's Head, FYN offers a unique blend of Japanese culinary techniques with African-inspired dishes, complemented by exceptional wine pairings
3. **La Colombe** | Silvermist Wine Estate, Constantia Nek, 7806 | +27 21 794 2390
Nestled in the Constantia Winelands, La Colombe is led by a multi-award-winning chef. The restaurant specializes in innovative French-Asian cuisine, beautifully plated with foraged ingredients.
4. **Kloof Street House** | 30 Kloof Street, Cape Town, 8005 | +27 21 423 4413
Housed in a Victorian mansion, Kloof Street House is known for its brasserie-style menu that adds an eclectic twist to classic South African comfort food. Don't miss the live jazz sessions on the first Sunday of every month.
5. **Thali** | 3 Park Road, Gardens, Cape Town, 8001 | +27 21 286 2110
Thali serves up an Indian tapas experience with a menu featuring eight mouthwatering dishes accompanied by sambals, poppadoms and tandoor. It's the go-to spot for exceptional curries.
6. **Hemelhuijs** | 71 Waterkant Street, Cape Town, 8001 | +27 21 418 2042
Located in the heart of the city, Hemelhuijs is a peaceful retreat known for its fresh juices, creative cocktails, fantastic coffee, and a seasonal menu that never disappoints.
7. **Belly of the Beast** | 110 Harrington Street, Cape Town, 8000 |
This intimate fine dining spot serves only 24 guests at a time, allowing for a focus on deep, rich flavors. With no set menu, guests are treated to a sustainable feast of expertly crafted courses.

ACTIVITIES

In & around Cape Town

- Sky Hi-Ride** | 9 Lower Long Street, Cape Town, 8000 | +27 21 879 5040
Located on the 28th floor, 146 meters above Cape Town, it provides a bird's-eye view of the city. It is an exhilarating and gravity-defying experience, offering a breathtaking free fall at speeds up to 100 km/h and nearly 4G's. This ride is one of only three in the world and the first of its kind in Africa.
- Hike Up Lion's Head** | Signal Hill Rd, Signal Hill, Cape Town, 8001
Lion's Head, the uniquely shaped peak adjacent to Table Mountain, offers breathtaking views. From the summit, you can see the city centre and Table Bay on one side, and the stunning beaches and mountains of Camps Bay on the other. On a clear day, the view stretches to the Cape Winelands and Robben Island.
- Relax at Clifton's 3rd Beach** | Victoria Road, Clifton, Cape Town, 8001
Cape Town is famous for its world-class beaches. Clifton's 3rd Beach is a popular spot for the LGBTQ+ community, especially gay men. The vibe is lively and fun, and the beach is less crowded than its neighbouring stretches, making it perfect for sunbathing in ideal weather.
- Wine Tasting at Cape Winelands** | Stellenbosch, 7599
The picturesque Cape Winelands, home to some of South Africa's oldest and most renowned wine estates, dates to the 1650s. Day trips to Franschhoek, Stellenbosch, and Paarl are easily arranged and a must for any Cape Town visit.
- Explore the Zeitz Museum** | V&A Waterfront Silo District, Cape Town, 8001
The Zeitz Museum of Contemporary Art Africa houses the largest collection of contemporary African art in the world. It's Cape Town's equivalent of the Tate Modern in London or the Guggenheim in New York.
- Picnic at Kirstenbosch Garden** | Rhodes Dr, Newlands, Cape Town, 7735
Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden is a perfect stop, especially when combined with a visit to the Constantia Winelands or Cape Point. Spread out a blanket and enjoy a picnic among the indigenous proteas and fynbos, all set against a stunning mountain backdrop.

1. **Café Manhattan** | 74 Waterkant Street, De Waterkant, Cape Town, 8051 | +27 21 429 666
One of Cape Town's oldest gay bars, Café Manhattan is a relaxed spot with great service, a solid menu, and regular entertainment like live music and art exhibitions.
2. **Beefcakes** | Sovereign Quay, Green Point, Cape Town, 8052 | +27 21 425 9019
This 1950s-style American diner serves up some of the city's best burgers alongside drag shows, stand-up comedy, and entertaining bingo nights.
3. **The Gin Bar** | 64A Wale Street, Cape Town, 8000 | +27 71 241 2277
Hidden behind Honest Chocolate, The Gin Bar is a gem with over 100 gin varieties, making it a local favorite for gin lovers.
4. **Publik** | 11D Kloofnek Road, Tamboerskloof
A cozy bar focused on 'new wave' wines from local vineyards, offering unique wines alongside delicious charcuterie and cheeses.
5. **Tjing Tjing** | 165 Longmarket Street, Cape Town, 8001 | +27 21 422 4374
A trendy rooftop bar in a 200-year-old building, offers Japanese street food at Torii Restaurant and modern Japanese dining at Momiji Lounge.
6. **The pink Candy** | 120 Strand St, De Waterkant, Cape Town, 8001 | +27 82 332 9051
A favourite of celebrities, locals and tourists alike, there is no better place to meet old friends, make new ones and dance the night away.
